

Proposal for the immediate installation of a Cardinal mark at West Cape Bay.

Yachts sunk and Yachts damaged:

Safety and dangerous and life-threatening situations have been ignored.

A number of yachts have been sunk and a significant number severely damaged by an unmarked rock in West Cape Bay with the most recent yacht sinking on the way home from the Adelaide to Lincoln race (White Knight CYCSA) in February 2020. The rock's coordinates have been supplied to the government in the hope that future loss of life and property can be avoided.

A cardinal (DANGER) mark should be positioned as soon as possible. (35.14.629S, 136.49.835E)
