Changes to the 2022 "King of the Gulf" regatta.

- 1. We are hoping that the entry to the marina will be dredged by the Yorke Council in time for our 2022 regatta. BUT if not, 2022 race start times will be scheduled as best we can around the tide times.
- All regatta divisions will have a five (5) race regatta program.
 This effectively means that the Cruising division will move from a 4 race to a 5 race series and the South Australian Multihull State Championship will move from a 7 race to a 5 race series program.
