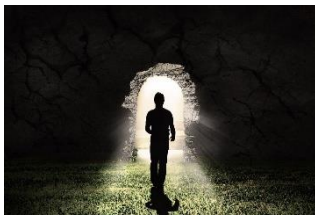

1. “Early Bird” nominations will open on Monday 18th along with meal bookings for the regatta.

2022 “King of the Gulf” meal options:

If you look at the website under “[Meal Tickets](#)” all the meal options are displayed with all the details you may require. At the moment all the tickets show, “sold out” preventing the purchase of meal tickets prior to Monday 18th October. On Monday 18th all tickets will be available for purchase. The exception could be the Saturday meal at the Port Vincent Sailing Club as the sailing club are still discussing their best COVID options.
