- 1. King of the Gulf "Early Bird" nominations are open now until the 31st December 2021.

3.	Sunday 6 th February	BBQ in the Marquee. You supply your meat/fish etc. and cook on the supplied BBQ's and we will have a range of fantastic salads from the bowls club. (Marquee limit is 150 people)

We will conduct the KOG presentations at 9.00pm and invite all KOG participants to the club for the presentations.
