# 1. NOMINATIONS ARE OPEN:

We have a good number of exciting yachts that have nominated already along with several interstate nominations. You can nominate through the regatta website www.myasa.asn.au or use this short cut. HERE.

# 2. **REGATTA MEALS:**

Meal bookings will be available for you to purchase on the website on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> November. We have been fortunate to secure the help of local service and sporting clubs in Port Vincent who provide meals for our event. *Tickets for meals will be available for sale online till Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023.* The web page now will show that everything is sold out. This is just to allow us to get the system all set up.

# 3. Yacht Insurance and Cat 5 and Cat 6 forms:

You do not have to upload these files into TopYacht if you are a member of the CYCSA, the Port Adelaide Sailing Club or the RSAYS. We will contact these three clubs directly to confirm you are currently compliant for racing in the KOG. Yachts nominating from other clubs will be required to upload your Cat5/6 form and insurance details into TopYacht so the documents can be validated by our race office.
